Presented in a manner where one can explore the lives of those individuals who have inspired and shaped today's society, many which have been ignored by modern day historians.

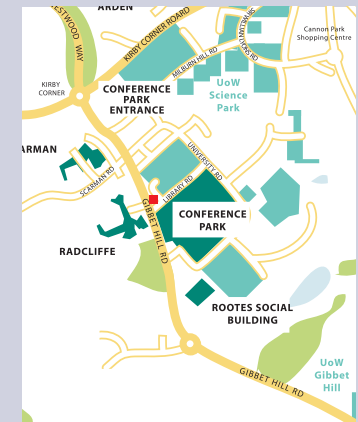
Exemplified is Mirabhai, who is generally a forgotten name to Sikhs today, but in fact is the sole example of a female author in the Sikh Holy scriptures.
